#### MONEY MATHS WORKSHOP YR 5/6

My Money Maths workshop is a practical way to develop financial literacy, teaching students not only how to look after their money, but also why they should care about it.

My Book Week presentation looks at how writing a non-fiction book is different to writing a novel or picture book.

Suitable for students of all genders in year 5/6, this presentation also aligns to the English study of informative texts.

#### Covers the following topics:

- · How to work out if there's an audience for your book idea.
- How (and when) to pitch your idea to publishers.
- How to conduct research and what makes a good source.
- · How to write for your audience.
- · How the editing process works.
